

Communicable Disease Action Plan (CDAP)

Four Stage Response System

Campus Begins in STAGE 0 – No CDAP stages in place



Absence rate of 7-14% in LS, MS, or US triggers STAGE 1

Absence of 15% of students in LS, MS, or US triggers STAGE 2

Rate must remain below 14% for 10 school days before returning to STAGE 1

Absence of 25% of students in LS, MS, or US triggers STAGE 3

Rate must remain below 15% for 10 school days before returning to STAGE 2

Government mandate or natural disaster triggers STAGE 4 and allowance for reopening
