San Marcos Academy requires payment by Registration. We realize this is not always financially convenient. Therefore, families who complete the tuition payment plan application are given the option of participating in either a monthly or semester plan. The payment plan rates are listed above. The sibling discount rate applies if a family has two or more students enrolled at San Marcos Academy. San Marcos Academy uses Smart Tuition for all invoicing and collections on student accounts.

Day Student Programs include the lunch meal, basic Infirmary care, internet access, and sports participation, including meals after away games. Please refer to the 2018-2019 Fee Schedule for the costs of Day Student morning or evening meals.

If a student is enrolled in the K-5 After-School Program, the Early Care Program is included for no additional charge.

Students participating in optional programs such as music lessons, private tutoring, and testing may be subject to additional fees. Field trips for the Lower and Middle School will have an additional cost. A special field trip to Washington, D.C. is planned for 8th grade. Please refer to the 2018-2019 Fee Schedule for the rates for these activities. All fees will be applied per student.

Parents are advised to plan for additional costs for school supplies, textbooks and uniforms for their students. The estimated cost for a first-year student varies depending on the grade and course schedule, but could be up to \$1,000.00. Please be prepared to pay at the Bookstore for all purchases during Registration. Cash, checks and credit cards are accepted.
