San Marcos Academy requires payment by Registration. We realize this is not always financially convenient. Therefore, families who complete the tuition payment plan application are given the option of participating in either a monthly or semester plan. The payment plan rates are listed above. The sibling discount rate applies if a family has two or more students enrolled at San Marcos Academy. We do require that International (I-20) students pay in full by Registration.

Boarding Student Programs include all cafeteria meals, all Student Activities trips, basic Infirmary care, internet access, sports participation (including meals after away games) and Residence Life services.

Please provide your student with a credit card or debit card to pay for any additional items he or she might need to purchase during the year.

Students who are participating in optional programs such as music lessons, private tutoring, and testing may be subject to additional fees. A special field trip to Washington, D.C. is planned for 8th grade. Please refer to the 2018-2019 Fee Schedule for the rates for these activities.

San Marcos Academy uses Smart Tuition for all invoicing and collections on student accounts.

Parents are advised to plan for additional costs for textbooks and uniforms for their students. The estimated cost for a first-year student could be up to \$1,500.00. Please be prepared to pay at the Bookstore for all textbook and uniform purchases during Registration. Cash, checks and credit cards are accepted.
