Tuition is due in its entirety once a student is enrolled. This amount may be paid in installments for families who complete the tuition payment application. San Marcos Academy requires payment by registration to qualify for the Pay In Full rate. Required fees are due by the first month's tuition due date. The sibling discount rate applies if a family has two or more students enrolled at San Marcos Academy. All fees will be applied per student unless noted as a family fee.

San Marcos Academy uses Smart Tuition for all invoicing and collections on student accounts. Each family will be charged the Smart Tuition Family Fee.

Day Student tuition includes the lunch meal and basic Student Health Center care. Please refer to the 2020-2021 Fee Schedule for the costs of Day Student morning or evening meals.

Students participating in optional programs such as music lessons, private tutoring, and testing may be subject to additional fees. Field trips for the Lower School and Middle School may require an additional cost. The After School Recreation Fee will be charged each semester for Middle School and Upper School students desiring access to after school facilities. If the student is participating in a sport, the semester fee will be waived.

Parents are advised to plan for additional costs for school supplies, textbooks and uniforms for their students. The estimated cost for a first-year student varies depending on the grade and course schedule, but could be up to \$1,000.00. Please be prepared to pay at the Bookstore or Bear Outfitters for all purchases during Registration. Cash, checks and credit cards are accepted.
