Tuition is due in its entirety once a student is enrolled at San Marcos Academy. For all non- international I-20 students, this amount may be paid in installments for families who complete the tuition payment application. San Marcos Academy requires payment by Registration to qualify for the Pay In Full rate. Required fees are due by the first month's tuition due date. The sibling discount rate applies if a family has two or more students enrolled at San Marcos Academy. All fees will be applied per student unless noted as a family fee.

San Marcos Academy uses Smart Tuition for all invoicing and collections on student accounts. Each family will be charged the Smart Tuition Family Fee.

Boarding Student Programs include all cafeteria meals, some Student Activities trips, basic Student Health Center care, After School Recreation access, internet access, and Residence Life services. Please refer to the 2020-2021 Fee Schedule for the costs of additional Student Health Center services.

Students participating in optional programs such as music lessons, private tutoring, and testing may be subject to additional fees. Field trips for the Middle School may require an additional cost.

Please provide your student with a credit card or debit card to pay for any additional items he or she might need to purchase during the year.

Parents are advised to plan for additional costs for school supplies, textbooks and uniforms for their students. The estimated cost for a first-year student varies depending on the grade and course schedule, but could be up to \$1,000.00. Please be prepared to pay at the Bookstore or Bear Outfitters for all purchases during Registration. Cash, checks and credit cards are accepted.
