

Advanced Placement (AP):

- AP is providing free remote learning resources in addition to your teacher's lessons. You can find these resources at <https://apstudents.collegeboard.org/coronavirus-updates#free-ap-classes>
- Face-to-face testing will NOT take place this year in May. In their places, students will take a 45-minute online free-response exam at home. These tests can be done on any device to which students have access--computer, tablet, or smartphone.
- Students may choose between two test dates to take their tests.
- The full exam schedule, specific free-response question types that will be on each AP exam, and additional testing details will be available by April 3rd. AP will also unlock any relevant free-response questions in AP Classroom for digital use so students can access all practice questions for the exams.
- ANY STUDENT ALREADY REGISTERED FOR AN EXAM CAN CHOOSE TO CANCEL AT NO CHARGE. PLEASE NOTIFY MRS. NASH IF YOU CHOOSE TO CANCEL AN EXAM.
- Exam topics will only include topics and skills most AP teachers and students have already covered in class. You will be contacted by your teacher on updates of what will be covered on the exam.
- Colleges are all aware of these changes to the AP exam and support the AP decisions that have been made.
- Course specific information and what is covered on the exam at this point are as follows (if anything changes, your AP teacher will let you know):
 - Calculus AB will cover Units 1-7
 - Calculus BC will cover Units 1-8 plus 5 topics in Unit 10 (10.2, 10.5, 10.7, 10.8, and 10.11)
 - Chemistry will cover Units 1-7
 - Chinese Language and Culture will cover Units 1-4
 - Computer Science A will cover Units 1-7
 - Computer Science Principles will have no AP written final. The student will be assessed on the Explore Task and Create Task only.
 - Macroeconomics will cover Units 1-5
 - Environmental Science will cover Units 1-7
 - Physics 1 will cover Units 1-7
 - Physics C: Mechanics will cover Units 1-5
