Financial Report 2019-2020 Ms. Bawcom reviewed the 2019-2020 year end report with a closing balance of \$4,652.25. The current cub network financial report shows a balance of \$7,455.29 (reports attached)

Funding request Amanda Robbins presented a funding request for the Lower School Library. She has purchased books previously through the Jr. Library Guild; there is a new religious book collection available at a discounted price. This includes 14 books, plus an additional 10 for \$219.60.

Ms. Robbins also discussed the birthday book program, which includes all celebrations (baptisms, etc..) This would be a flat rate. Parents are able to pick the book and the child's name would be on a nameplate at the inside of the book. Ms. Robbins will let the cub network know how to roll out the program. Early Act Service Project Ms. Amy Bawcom discussed the service sponsored project by the Rotary Club. Ms. Goode and Ms. Lucas are the Lower school sponsors. This is a character education program with service opportunities, based on the Bible character traits. The first project will be collecting plastic bottle caps, which are melted down and traded for money. These funds are donated to a charity in Mexico to pay for a child receiving chemotherapy.
