Fundraising efforts:

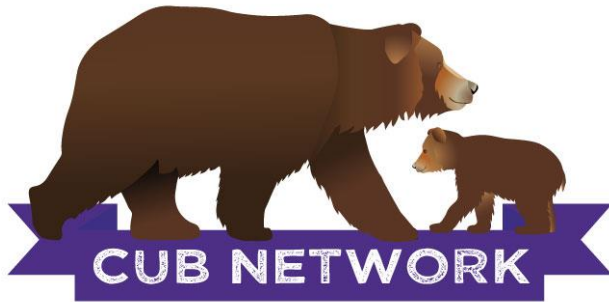
- Change War
