



The San Marcos Academy Cub Network is hosting some fun theme shirt days this year! The theme days are intended as a fundraiser, similar to the dress down days you sometimes see as an upper school fundraiser. Basically, you can “buy in” to the Cub Network shirt day with a one-time pass payment or with a monthly donation to Cub Network!

There are two options for making your donation:

1. Make a \$5 donation for each month your child will be participating via the Smart Tuition link <https://bngn.smarttuition.com/?id=ctwhyktnnef> no later than 5 p.m. the night before the dress up day.
2. Make one lump donation for the entire year’s worth of once-a-month dress up theme days. This annual “Theme Shirt” pass option is \$35, a discount of \$10 from the monthly purchases. This donation can be made via Smart Tuition: <https://bngn.smarttuition.com/?id=ctwhyktnnef>.

**Important Notes:**

- Please have your donation made by the day BEFORE the dress up day. This is the only way we can provide teachers with a list of dress code-compliant students.
- Theme shirts should be worn with jeans or uniform pants/shorts/skorts and should comply with the dress code.
- Please note that your student must comply with the standard dress code if they do not have a dress up theme pass paid for on their student account.
